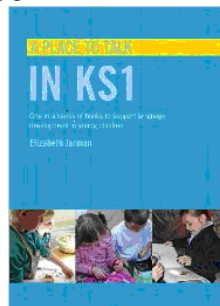

## A Place to Talk in KS1

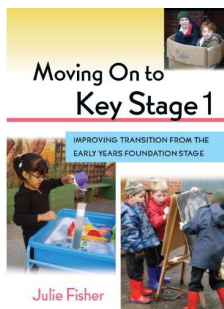

## Moving On To Key Stage 1

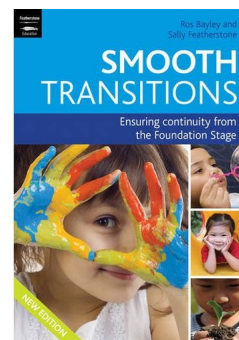

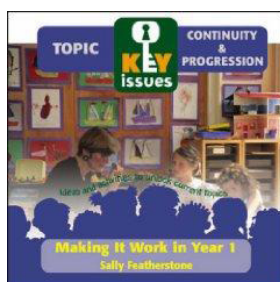
