

Framework for the Level 2 Certificate for the Children and Young People's Workforce

The certificate has been developed to be 35 credits in size and is a combination of knowledge and competence units. It is designed to be a generic qualification for the wider children's workforce that reflects the common core and provides progression to the Level 3 Diploma.

The Level 2 Certificate for the Children and Young People's Workforce will be an excellent preparation for the Level 3 Diploma for the Children and Young People's Workforce. It will confer occupational competence to work under supervision and enable practitioners to count in the ratio at level 2 identified in the Statutory Framework for the Early Years Foundation Stage
